

OFFICIAL MASTER IN GENERAL HEALTH CARE PSYCHOLOGY – PART-TIME

In the event that students do the master's course part-time, credits will be arranged as follows:

1st academic year: 30 credits (October-June)

- Basic Skills of Psychologists (7 credits)
- Assessment and Diagnosis in General Health Care Psychology (5 credits)
- Assessment and Intervention in Children and Youth (4 credits)
- Assessment and Intervention in Adults 1 (8 credits)
- Assessment and Intervention in Adults 2 (6 credits) (Second semester)

2nd academic year: 30 credits (October-June)

- Scientific and Professional Bases of Health Care Psychology (6 credits)
- 3 optional subjects (12 credits) (Second semester)
- Practicum 1 (January-June) (12 credits)

3rd academic year: 30 credits (September-February/September)

- Practicum II (September-December) (18 credits)
- Master's Final Dissertation (September-February/September) (12 credits)

TOTAL: 90 CREDITS

Important information

- This slow track has to be taken in three consecutive academic years.
- Enrolment in the part-time programme allows candidates to change to full-time up until September in the first academic year of their master's course.
