

Regulations applying to the Blanquerna School of Health Science's placements

At the start of the school year the student will be provided with information which is relevant to placements, and also to the rules concerning the way these are allocated, which must be kept in mind.

The student will have to respect these rules which are specific to the center where the placement takes place, and must be aware of and abide by the regulations drawn up by FCS Blanquerna which apply to placements, which are the following:

1. Placements cannot be carried out in the center where a work-related activity is being done
2. As far as work-related clothing is concerned, the student must:
 - Wear a complete, clean uniform
 - Wear FCS Blanquerna or the one provided by the placement center personal identification on the uniform
 - Complementary clothing must not be worn over the uniform (in exceptional cases an item of clothing may be permitted by the center providing the placement)
 - If the student wears an item to cover his/her head, this must be white and only for placement purposes
 - It is forbidden to leave the school premises or those of the placement center in uniform unless it happens to be a placement requirement
 - Pockets must only be used for necessary task-related material for placement purposes (not mobiles or the like)
3. As far as Hygiene is concerned, the student must:
 - Tie up long hair, and beards must be short and kempt
 - Keep nails short and unpainted
 - Not wear jewelry (rings, necklaces...) and, earrings (if worn) must be small
 - Smoking is forbidden inside and outside the placement premises (in accordance with the anti-smoking law which has been applicable since 2 January 2011)
 - If special protection is necessary (mask, gloves, lab coat...) you will have to refer to the center professional
4. To create and enhance attitudes concerning respect and personal and professional identity, the following is required:
 - Communication with the patient, his/her family and/or the placement center personnel must be respectful and they must be addressed as "vostè/usted"
 - You must arrive at the allocated center at the time and on the day agreed by the center and the university
 - When dealing with patients, comments will not be made about the illness and/or treatment, neither to the professional nor the patient, nor the family
 - Confidentiality is essential regards internal information related to the placement center and concerning activities carried out during the placement and when it is completed
5. Repeating the placement in the same center is not an option during the academic year
